Are there prerequisites to participate in the Summer School?

The prerequisites to be able to fully benefit from this training are:

- A global understanding of sustainable development;
- Experience in collaborative work;
- To be fully able to work and exchange in one of Canada's two official languages;
- To be available for sessions scheduled in the time zone of the province of Quebec (EST);
- Be equipped with a computer or tablet and a stable high-speed internet connection.

When will registration be open?

Registration is based on assessment of an application, according to the following schedule:

- Online application starts: March 5, 2021
- Application deadline: April 28, 2021 at 11:59pm EST
- Announcement of successful applications and online registration opens: May 27, 2021

Only selected candidates will be able to register.

If your application is not selected for this edition, we will invite you to join the community of practice that will be set up during the School, and we will be happy to count you among our contributors to promote the necessary socio-ecological transition.

How can I apply?

You must fill in the online form. It takes approximately 45 minutes to complete. At any time, you may save your form and come back to it to complete it later.

Required documents are:

- Summary of your experience (resume or link to your LinkedIn profile).
- Short video presentation of 3mn.

Is the Summer School a university-accredited program?

Does the Summer School provide a training certificate?

Yes. A 45-hour training certificate will be provided.

I am a professional. If selected, how can I register?

If your application is selected, information about the registration process will be communicated to you at that time.

I am a student. If selected, how can I register?

If your application is selected, you will be able to register at Concordia University starting May 27, 2021. Information regarding the registration process will be communicated to you at that time.

Graduate students from other Québec universities must submit requests for courses through the [Inter-University Agreement \(AEHE/BCI\)](#) process. We recommend that you explore this process and contact your program director before you receive confirmation that your application has been selected.

Graduate students from Canadian universities outside of Québec must complete the Graduate Transfer Agreement between Canadian Universities (CAGS) form or obtain a letter (or form) of authorization from their home university. This document must be submitted to the degree program offering the course in which they are interested. We recommend that you explore this process and contact your program director before you receive confirmation that your application has been selected.

Does the Summer School have an Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Policy in place?

I don't seem to fit in the categories of participants...

If you are unemployed or self-employed at the time of the Summer School, you will be able to benefit from the Non-profit organizations rate if your application is accepted (\$995+tx).

If you are a Bachelor's student at the time of registration, but are already registered and accepted for a Master's program for the session starting in September 2021 , you can apply.

Government employees of Quebec or Canadian ministries can benefit from the "Agents for the promotion of territorial sustainable development" rate if their application is accepted (1295\$+tx)
